When services are covered, insurance will pay according to the patient's benefits. Any remaining balance - such as copays, coinsurance, or deductibles - may be the patient's responsibility if not covered by additional insurance. Please note that out-of-pocket costs may vary throughout the year depending on insurance coverage and whether deductibles have been met.
